After a lengthy discussion the members decided that the targeted public education and outreach best management practices will include household hazardous waste disposal, illicit discharge detection and elimination, pesticide and fertilizer application, pet waste management, recycling to include trash management and vehicle washing. The specific audiences targeted will be residential. The members also decided to review what Jayme can do for free for the coalition that BME is not already doing so there isn't duplication of services. They will begin that review toward the end of the fiscal year. Brian Frey suggested that the coalition follow the minimum measure guidelines that are required in the permit. Kim Boyd felt that all the current brochures need to be updated (Edith). When they are updated they should be on the new website. Kim and Edith should present the Stormwater management plan to the Town and Village Boards that are members. The MM #2 looks good as presented but possibly adding a rain barrel program. Kim felt the public should be made aware of bio-retention and she will contact Broccolo Landscape for ideas/pricing for rain garden installations in the member buildings.

<u>WEBSITE UPDATE-</u>Kurt Rappazzo asked for the logo's that have not been provided, more photos are needed. Kim suggested a group photo. Updates should be given at the next meeting.

<u>INTERN-</u>Rebecca Munro was in attendance and stated that she has been in the Town of Ontario, Town of Macedon and is currently in Wayne County Highway. The purchase of a new GPS/GIS unit was discussed, no decision was made.
