

**MINUTES OF THE ONTARIO-WAYNE STORMWATER COALITION
WALWORTH TOWN HALL
FEBRUARY 19, 2019**

CAUSEWAVE

Alaina briefly explained the survey Phase I; there will be edits done before a public distribution; Alaina will send out the link this PM. Each municipality can send out to their own respective contacts and it can be sent out to school districts, chamber of commerce, fire departments, libraries, etc. Daniel Kenney (representing Kim Boyd) stated the contract has been signed by Chairman Frey.

INTERN POSITION

There is no update on the intern position. Lindsey may have some local candidates that may be interested in the position.

ALAINA UPDATE

There will be a rain barrel workshop in April; \$20 cost for materials, more info to follow. She presented at the Wayne County HS Science Fair on January 15th, IDDE presentations at the Town and Village of Victor on January 16th, February 6th at the Town of Farmington, February 26th at the Town of Macedon and on the 27th the Town of Walworth and Wayne County Highway. On March 21st CLWA is hosting a lake friendly presentation. March 7th is a soil health workshop and April 25th is the Envirothon including Ontario, Yates and Seneca Counties. She will be doing a science presentation at Pal-Mac on April 26th.

ANNUAL REPORT

Daniel Kenney stated the reporting period will end March 9th, the deadline to BME is April 12th, public comment until May 17th and to DEC by May 28th. The Town of Farmington has been selected for the DEC audit; there are two others in Monroe County.

NEW BUSINESS

Lindsey is trying to schedule a Wayne County tire cleanup possibly in July, it will be costly. Lindsey suggested an annual program starting in 2020 for e-waste, tires and to include farm chemicals. Paul Crandall asked if there has been any news regarding Western NY Stormwater conference, none to date. Lindsey reminded everyone about the invasive workshop on March 28th, more info to follow.

The next meeting will be held at the Victor Town Hall on March 19th.
